Race Rules

1. The race is run in accordance with the rules of CGA and ASA.
2. Registered athletes must be members of a club affiliated to ASA and wear club colours with a licence number displayed on the front and the back of the vest. Only 2018 CGA licences will be allowed.
3. Temporary licensed athletes must wear plain clothing & temporary licence on the front of the vest.
4. Athletes do not need to belong to a club to enter the race.
5. Race tag in the packet must be worn throughout the race.
6. Temporary licences must be purchased if you do not belong to a club.
7. Only junior athletes between 15 & 19 years of age qualify for prizes.
8. Runners must be 15 years old or older on the day of the race.
9. Numerical age identity tags must be worn visibly, front and back.
 - Proof of age to be produced on race day, if requested.
10. No blade, cyclist or mechanically operated devices allowed in the race.
11. All traffic officials to be obeyed.
12. Athletes indemnify the national, provincial and regional bodies, sponsors and organisers of the race against all or any action of whatsoever nature, whatever same be arising out of their participation in the race.
13. Foreign athletes are to comply with ASA domestic rules. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
14. Foreign athletes must provide clearance from their controlling athletics body (IAAF member federation).
15. Blind runners must produce a BP number upon request.
16. No seconding will be allowed.
17. Entry fee is not refundable regardless of circumstances.
18. Walkers and blind runners are welcome to participate in all race distances.
19. Refreshment tables every 3km.
20. Safe tog bag area will be provided.
21. No cut off time.
22. Regret athletes not allowed to participate with pets (dogs).
23. Prizewinners will be eligible for prizes only if all info is filled in on the information sticker/tear off
24. Half price entry to Grand Masters provided age tags are worn or proof of age is provided.
